About the SPTS Kevin Wilk Traveling Fellowship

Residencies and fellowships help develop sports physical therapists' abilities for advanced competencies in the field. These programs allow professionals to develop their skills under the mentorship of a recognized clinical expert.

However, residencies and fellowships require the dedication of many hours of time toward the program...something that can be difficult to arrange in the post-graduate world.

The AASPT created the AASPT Kevin Wilk Traveling Fellowship to satisfy the need for an advanced educational experience in a compressed time frame. Fellows spend a single week traveling to three educational sites, spending one to two days each with noted leaders in our field. At each site, fellows will be involved in various activities.

The AASPT Traveling Fellowship is funded by AASPT and corporate sponsor DJO Global, which allows a class of three AASPT members to participate twice each year.
